

Halloween

Please make a note of the following guidelines for the upcoming celebration of Halloween at school:

Halloween will be celebrated on Friday, October 30th. **Our students will be dismissed at 11:48 AM due to a staff inservice that will take place in the afternoon. (No lunches will be served)**

The Halloween parade will begin at 8:45 AM. *Parents are welcome to join us, but we ask that you go to the cafeteria or gym where chairs will be set up for you. This way, the parade can move smoothly through the halls. After the parade, the students will return to their classrooms for individual activities. Children will have a drink and one snack in their room. The room celebration will be planned in advance by the teacher, room parents or a committee of students, so please refrain from dropping in with treats if you have not been asked to send them. The children will receive plenty of candy at Halloween and our room celebrations are well planned.

Students may wear their costume to school on the bus, but we ask that any loose accessories be brought to school in a bag. We also ask that children do NOT wear masks, but make-up is allowed. In keeping with the district policy, we will NOT allow toy weapons of any kind to be part of any costume and ask that violence not be portrayed.

In the interest of safety, we ask that any parent who chooses to come to school in costume refrain from wearing a mask or anything else that would not allow us to recognize you. Parents will not need to check into the office on this special day, but MUST remain in the cafeteria or gym. Any parent who will be helping out in the classroom will be expected to check into the office and be given a guest tag.
